# **Rectangle Banner Flag & Pole Set Safety Instructions**



- **Warning.** Only use rectangle banner flag & pole set in area clear of power lines, structures, trees, cars, buildings, people, hazardous weather etc...
- Ensure rectangle banner flag & pole set is only used in clear open area to avoid damaging or creating hazardous situations.
- **!** Warning. Do not use if winds exceed 18 mph.
- Install at least 8 feet away from road.
- Do not use rectangle banner flag & pole set if showing any sign of damage. Check for damage before each use
- Do not use aftermarket parts.
- Do not modify in any way.
- Only assemble pole components in clear open area free of any hazards.
- Do not use in dangerous environments.
- Do not force pole set pieces together. Pole pieces fit together when assembled properly.
- Use personal protective equipment such as protective eyewear and gloves when setting up.
- Only set up rectangle banner flag & pole set using secured system. Examples of secured systems include ground spike, anchored X-stand, company provided base unit, etc...
- Store rectangle banner flag & pole set indoors when not in use.

## **Ground Spike**

- **Caution.** Do not hammer pole set "adapter rod" when securing spike in ground. Only hammer solid top of the spike
- Use rubber mallet to force spike into the ground.
- Only use if spike is hammered all the way into the ground, at a minimum of 16 inches, so that pole receptacle is the only component above ground.
- Only use ground spike in flat, stable, and dry ground.
- Use personal protective equipment such as protective eyewear and gloves when setting up.

### X-stand

- /! Warning. Only use X-stand indoors or in areas with less than 1 mph winds.
- Only use X-stand when anchored with water bag, sand bag, or other anchoring system.
- Always secure dowel into x-legs firmly.
- Always operate on flat, stable, and dry surface.
- Use personal protective equipment such as protective eyewear and gloves when setting up.

# Rectangle Banner Flag Pole Set

#### Step 1:

Check to make sure all parts are included. Then, slide all silver straight upright pieces into each other, making one long straight pole. This will vary in length depending on the size of your flag.

#### Step 2:

Slide the straight poles into the long side sleeve of the flag.

#### Step 3:

Slide the black angled pole into the top sleeve of the flag, long side first. The short angled end should still be out. Then tuck the short end of the black angled pole just inside the top of the long side sleeve.

#### Step 4:

Inside of the long side sleeve, insert the short end of the black angled pole into the top of the long pole assembly.

#### Step 5a:

If using an X Stand, place the leg with a depression in the middle down first, set the other leg on top of it in an "x" shape, then screw the dowel into the X legs. Insert flag pole onto the dowel.

#### Step 5b:

If using a ground spike, hammer the spike into the ground by hitting only the solid top of the spike (not the pole set receptacle). Insert flag pole onto the receptacle.

#### Step 6:

Locate the black loop holder on the bottom pole. Unscrew to loosen, slide to adjust height and bring close to loop of flag. Hook loop of flag onto loop holder. Adjust to firm hold, then tighten down the screw to secure the flag in place.
